Welcome to City Seminary of Sacramento

City Seminary of Sacramento is a graduate level theological institution committed to providing a classical theological education to divinity students in the Sacramento region. The Seminary offers programs leading to the degrees of Associate of Theological Studies and Master of Theological Studies (2-year); Bachelor of Divinity and Master of Divinity (4-year); and, Certificates in Apologetics, Church History, New Testament, Old Testament, Systematic Theology and Pastoral Theology.

This registration form should be used by 1) returning students to register in City Seminary's classes for the Fall 2008 semester; and, 2) New students who have already submitted their Application for Admission, or who are doing so concurrently. In the latter case, registration will only be processed once a student's Application for Admission has been approved.

Tuition fees for the Fall 2008 semester are \$225 per semester hour, and \$50 per semester hour for those auditing courses and Christian school teachers taking courses for ACSI CEU credit. The maximum tuition per semester for full-time students enrolled in a degree program is \$2,700. Various financial aid packages are available.
